The user interface can be translated into any language, including Russian, Chinese, and French.



Data is stored in a standard time-zone-independent format so there is no risk of data conflicts from different users.

- Personal time zones for users
- Appointments show local time zone
- Custom reports capability
- Data stored as Unicode
- Translates into any language

Everyone in JobTraQ can use their own local time zone for all calendars, dates, and schedules. The system automatically translates all dates to and from each person's local time, including Daylight Saving Time adjustments.

Data is stored as Unicode strings with UTF-16 encoding, so users can record data in any language necessary.
